#### PART 2: IS MY BIBLE THE ONLY BIBLE?

Just like money can be counterfeited, the Bible, which is God's Word, can also be counterfeited. In ancient times and even today, there are religions using "Bibles" (sources of authority) that are not from God. So, what are these counterfeit Bibles and how can I be sure I have the only Bible from God?

# WHAT OTHER "BIBLES" (SOURCES OF AUTHORITY) ARE THERE?

Examples of <u>ancient writings</u> which existed during the early church period include Apocryphal books, Pseudepigrapha books, Gnostic Gospels, Hindu Vedas, Qur'an, and the Jewish Talmud.

Examples of <u>contemporary sources of authority</u> include the King James Bible-Mormon version, New World Translation (Jehovah's Witnesses), Key to Health& Scriptures (Christian Science), and Bibles containing apocryphal books (e.g., New Jerusalem Bible, NSRV Catholic Bible).

# HOW CAN I KNOW WHICH "BIBLE" IS TRULY FROM GOD?

In order to know which writings were inspired by God, and which were not, the early Christian church had to have a standard against which each writing could be tested. This standard is known as the canon of Scripture.

## THE CANON OF SCRIPTURE

Canonicity refers to the church's recognition and acceptance of the books of Scripture as God's inspired Word. The term itself comes from the Greek word kanōn which originally meant a "reed" or a "rod." Since a rod was frequently used as a measuring stick the word began to convey the idea of a standard or rule.

Criteria for scriptural canonicity:

	Authentic	authorship
•	Authentic	authorship

•	Consistent	with existing Scripture.
•	Universal	by the early Christian church.
•	The canon is from it.	Nothing is to be added to the Bible or taken away

#### **KEY POINT**



- A Geiger counter detects radioactive material, it does *not* make the material radioactive.
