 $m{T}$ he term "anthropology" comes from two Greek words, namely, Anthropos meaning "man" and logos meaning "word, matter, or thing." The word "anthropology" refers to the study of man and Biblical anthropology is the study of man as understood primarily from Scripture. Therefore, it often involves discussion of the particular creation of man as he was made in the "image of God," the constitutional nature of man, and man after the fall.
