

PART 11: THE RESTORATION PERIOD

The Jews had to wait in exile 70 years and during this time they had to be very patient. At the end of the 70 years God moved the heart of Cyrus, king of Persia, to let his people return to Jerusalem (Ezra 1:1-4). The Cyrus Cylinder gives us biblical evidence of this restoration.

THE RESTORATION PERIOD

• The Jews returned to Jerusalem in three waves (See the books of Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther).



- The first wave of returnees: Zerubbabel brought 42,360 Jews to Jerusalem in 537 B.C. ¹
- The second wave of returnees: Ezra brought about 2,000 Jews to Jerusalem in 458 B.C.
- The third wave of returnees: Only a few Jews returned with Nehemiah around 445 B.C.

¹ The remaining Jews stayed in Babylon. Historians estimate there were between 100,000 and 150,000 Jews living in Babylon prior to the return to the Promised Land. The number of remaining Jews at this time would then be about 50,000 to 100,000.
